Era of gangsters, Prohibition & the Great Depression







Eleanor dyed her hair red while in hiding.



PRIMARY SOURCE DOCUMENTATION for alias — Marie Millman



- NO paper trial prior to 1951
- Denver City Directories 1951-1980 (no surviving neighbors)
- Social Security (SS Death Index, but no SS-5 application)
- NO "hints" on MARIE's tree
- Denver Probate File for MARIE
 H. MILLMAN shows NO HEIRS
 (& no family at all)

Pete's Kitchen today: No records, previous owners deceased



PROBATE FILE REVEALED MARIE'S GRAVE



IS MARIE (died 1980) ELEANOR?


If alias provided by family is correct, I believe so. Only an exhumation and DNA research can tell us for sure.

But I never do. I keep hoping that she got some good out of life... Goodnight, Eleanor Jarman, wherever you are.


