

Microsoft Word: **Styles and Themes**



Styles - Home Tab

A **style** is a predefined combination of font style, color, size of text and more that can be applied to **selected text**. It can be used to show hierarchy in text by using consistent formatting options.





Themes - Design Tab

A theme is a set of formatting choices that can be applied to an entire document and includes theme colors, fonts, and effects.





Table of Contents - References Tab
