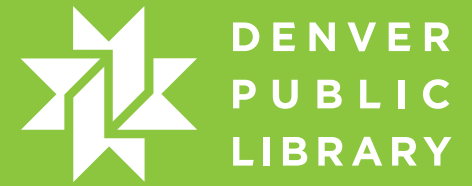

## For the Homebound Customer...



If physical limitations keep you from visiting a Denver Public Library, let our Homebound Service bring the Library to you.

The Denver Public Library will match you with a volunteer who will visit you and help you make your reading or listening selections; then pick up and deliver materials to you. You can enjoy the Library's entire collection, including more than

2.2 million books (including large print), DVDs and CDs without leaving home!

Your Homebound library card lets you borrow books for up to six



weeks, while other materials, such as CDs, DVDs check out for shorter periods. You're not responsible for fines on overdue items, but will be assessed a

fee for any lost materials.

Together, you and your Homebound volunteer can arrange visits so that you always have books, DVDs and CDs to enrich your life.

To take part in the Homebound Service, call 720-865-1351. Information needed to enroll include name, address, daytime phone number and date of birth. You must be a Denver resident.

Once you're enrolled in the service, a volunteer will contact you in three to six weeks depending upon availability.



## For the Homebound Service Volunteer...

Imagine the joy of bringing library services to someone who can't visit the Denver Public Library.

"Rewarding," "fun," and "caring" are just a few ways our volunteers describe what they do - pick up and deliver books, DVDs and CDs to homebound customers. Plenty of good book talk and great friendships develop along the way.

Volunteering for a homebound customer takes very little time - an average of five hours every six weeks. Volunteers are matched with customers according to geographic location.

A valid driver's license and successful completion of a background check are required. Any metro-area resident is encouraged to volunteer.
