



K-5th Grade Virtual Classroom Visits

Library staff look forward to visiting your classroom (virtually) to nurture students' love of reading and lifelong learning!


How It Works




What: Visits include fun, engaging elements customized to support classroom learning goals and nurture a love of reading and lifelong learning.




Who: Visits are provided by passionate staff from a Denver Public Library branch near your school.




Why: Library staff connect with you and your students, inspire a love of reading, provide a sense of community and support social-emotional needs.



When: Scheduling is flexible. Visits are generally between 5-30 minutes and can be one time events or provided on a regular weekly/monthly basis.



Where: Visits can be pre-recorded (for asynchronous posting on classroom platforms) or presented live for synchronous interaction. Live visits can be recorded and posted.

<p><u>Read Alouds</u></p> <p>Build background knowledge, fluency, and a love of reading through fun, interactive read alouds that lift up diverse voices.</p>	<p><u>Virtual Bookshelf</u></p> <p>A classroom-specific webpage of curated titles, including readalikes, books shared during visits, popular topics, and more!</p>	<p><u>Music, Movement & More</u></p> <p>Interactive and catchy, these fun activities foster a love of reading and build literacy skills.</p>
<p><u>Book Discussion</u></p> <p>Spark joy, engagement, and reflection with book discussion guides and/or library staff-led book discussions that involve the whole class or small groups.</p>	<p><u>Subject Book Lists & Resources</u></p> <p>Books, databases and other resources to support classroom learning. Option for library staff to share resources in a fun, engaging presentation or create a teacher set for quick and easy pickup.</p>
